The Closing Ceremony of the “Training Program on Agricultural Irrigation” for Afghanistan was held at Agricultural Education and Research Institute in Karaj on September 7th, 2016.

This seminar was a joint Iran and Japan training program conducted in Iran for third country’s trainees from Afghanistan. Fifteen Afghan governmental officers, who were invited to Iran, participated in this twelve-day Agricultural Irrigation Management Program.

It is more effective to carry out such courses in Iran rather than in any other countries, since Iran and Afghanistan enjoy almost similar culture and the lecturers can directly communicate trainees in Farsi.
