

Signing Ceremony of Japan Grant Aid Project on “Integrated Programme for Sustainable Water Resources Management in the Lake Urmia Basin”

The signing ceremony of the Promoting Partnership between FAO and the Urmia Lake Restoration National Committee on “Integrated Programme for Sustainable Water Resources Management in the Lake Urmia Basin” was held at the Sharif University of Technology in Tehran on 6 September 2016.

Based on the critical situation of Lake Urmia, Japan Grant Aid Project at 436 million Japanese Yen, equivalent to 3 million 683 thousand and 8 hundred USD for the next 4 years was contributed to FAO in March 2016.
