

Visit to UNHCR Project in Yazd Province

H.E. Ambassador Koji HANEDA, visited UNHCR's Project in Yazd Province from May 27th to May 28th to survey the support to Afghan refugees' settlements. The Japanese Government has donated US\$ 2.4 million to UNHCR, as activity costs in 2015, which have been used in the voluntary repatriation, educational, health fields, etc.
