

Project for Rice-based Agriculture Development in Afghanistan “Closing Ceremony”

Closing Ceremony of the Project for Rice-based Agriculture Development in Afghanistan was held at Haraz Extension and Technology Development Center (HETD) in Mahmoudabad city, Amol, on August 27th, 2015.

This project was planned to be held in Afghanistan, targeting Afghanistan officials regarding agriculture. But since security situation in Afghanistan went bad by that time, it was decided to hold it in Iran, where there are the same language and almost common culture.
