

Relief Donation from Japanese People Residing in Tehran To the Victims of Iran Northwest Earthquake

Mr. Kanno, Head of Japanese Association in Tehran, handed over the amount of relief donation (45 million Rials (about \$ 3,700)) from Japanese Association in Tehran to Mr. Okubo, Head of SNS International Disaster Prevention Support Center, in the presence of H.E. Mr. Komano, Ambassador of Japan in Iran, on 27th September 2012, at the Japanese Embassy premises.

Since the average temperature of October dropped to about 8 in the quake-stricken areas, the SNS International Disaster Prevention Support Center decided to support the earthquake victims by distributing heavy winter clothing through Japanese Government donation (up to about 10 million Yen). This relief donation will be used as a part of this support.

SNS International Disaster Prevention Support Center started distributing heavy winter clothing directly in the disaster areas from 23th September, and will continue distributing 3,300 more heavy winter clothing afterwards.
