

Embassy of Japan in Iran Held Handover Ceremony of the Mobile Clinic in Response to the Damage Caused by Floods in Iran

The Embassy of Japan in the Islamic Republic of Iran held the Handover Ceremony of the Mobile Clinic at the National Emergency Medical Organization in Tehran on 17th November in response to the damage caused by floods in Iran. H.E. Ambassador Saito from the Japanese side, Dr. PirHossein Koulivand, Head of National Emergency Medical Organization, Ministry of Health and Medical Education and Dr. Mohsen Asadi-Lari, Director General of International Affairs, Ministry of Health and Medical Education from the Iranian side, and Dr. Christoph Hamelmann, WHO Representative in the Islamic Republic of Iran, attended the ceremony.


This item is one of the supports for providing the urgent health care services to the people affected by the floods that H.E. Mr. Shinzo Abe, Prime Minister of Japan conveyed to H.E. Dr. Hassan Rouhani, President of the Islamic Republic of Iran at the Japan-Iran summit meeting held on this June. This WHO project provides primary health care services by delivering the mobile clinic and laboratory as well as the essential vaccines and the medicine. In the framework of this project, WHO also provided the capacity-building activities to train Iranian relevant health professionals.

H.E. Ambassador Saito said that the floods hit vast parts of Iran and the damages to the health sector by the floods was serious, so the provision of the essential health service to the people, who were suffering from the floods was an urgent need. In this regard, the Government of Japan has decided to extend an Emergency Grant Aid through WHO. He added that we were here to hand over a mobile clinic, which was procured by the donation of Japan and sincerely hoped that it would contribute to provide the necessary health services for the suffering people in the affected area.

At the end of the Ceremony, the label of Japanese Flag was attached on the Mobile Clinic. This Mobile Clinic is ready to provide the necessary health services for the suffering people in the affected areas.
